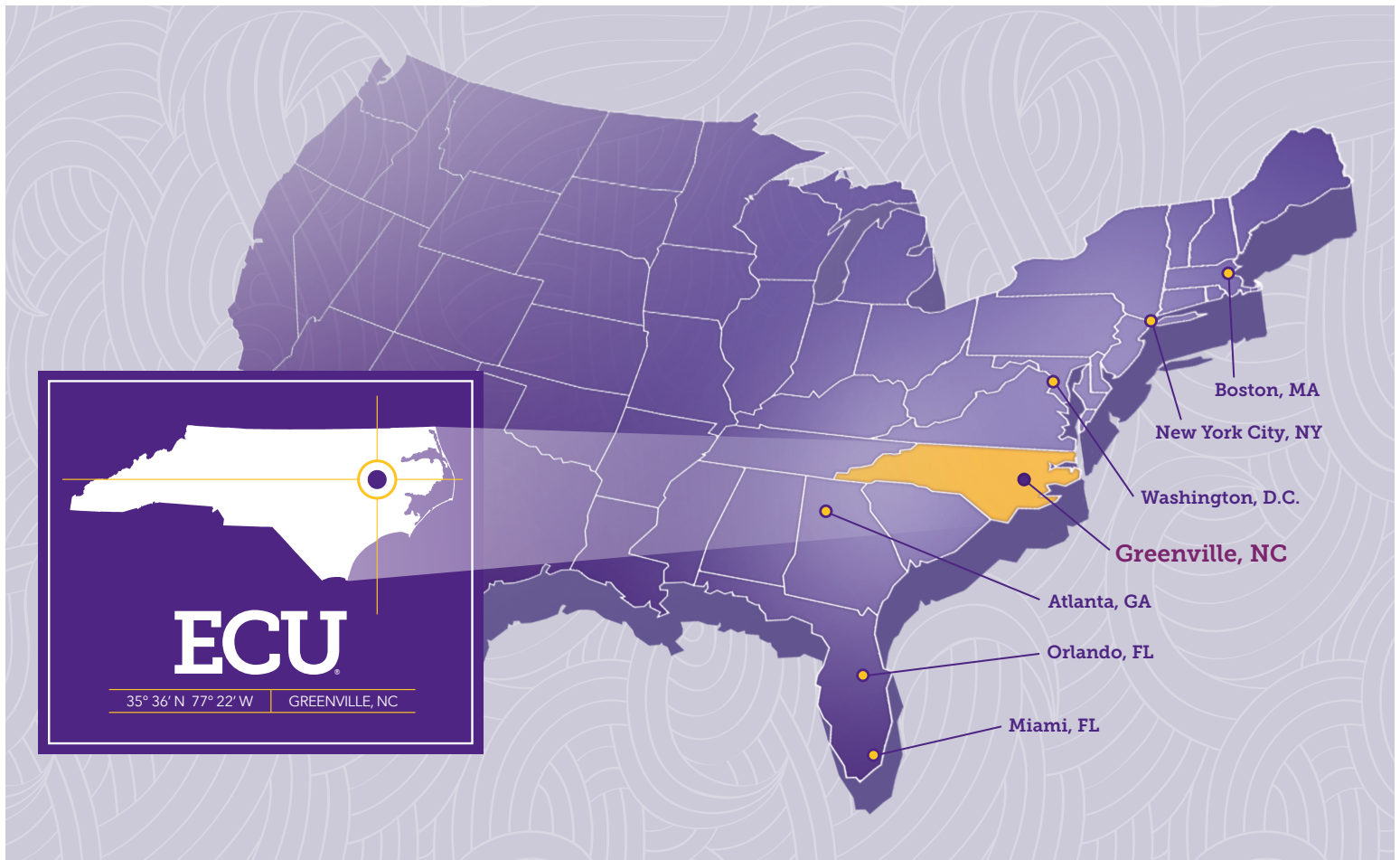

## About Greenville

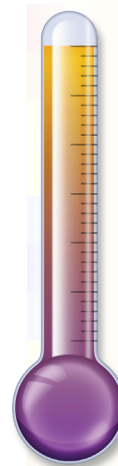

Boasting a population of more than 90,000, Greenville is among North Carolina's largest cities. The state of North Carolina has something for everyone, from snow-covered mountains in the West to tranquil beaches in the East. At ECULA, we are committed to your success. Our intensive academic English program is fully accredited through the Commission on English Language Program Accreditation (CEA), meeting the

highest standards in language instruction with friendly and helpful faculty. We can offer conditional admission into undergraduate programs for students who do not meet the minimum English proficiency requirement.

## Admission Requirements

1. Submit online application
2. Submit \$75 application fee
3. Submit academic transcript\*
4. Submit one of the following exam scores:
  - Duolingo English Test: minimum total score of 105
  - IELTS: minimum band score of 6.0
  - TOEFL: minimum total score of 71
  - ACT: minimum English section score of 19
  - SAT: minimum English section score of 450

Exceptions to the English proficiency exam score can be considered on a case-by-case basis for students from English-speaking countries or education in English-instructed schools.

We can offer conditional admission through the ECU Language Academy for students who do not meet the minimum English proficiency requirement.

\* Students who have previously studied at a higher education institution outside the United States must submit a course-by-course international credential evaluation from an NACES-accredited evaluation company.



### Application Deadlines

- December 1: Deadline to be eligible to apply to the Honors College (fall admission only)
- December 15: Deadline for spring semester admission
- January 1: Deadline to be eligible to apply for other merit-based scholarships (Please note: Scholarships are not awarded upon admission.)
- July 15: Deadline for fall semester admission
