
A Guide for International Admissions

Admission Requirements

- 1. Submit online application
- 2. Submit \$75 application fee
- 3. Submit academic transcript*
- 4. Submit one of the following exam scores:
 - Duolingo English Test: minimum total score of 105
 - IELTS: minimum band score of 6.0
 - TOEFL: minimum total score of 71
 - ACT: minimum English section score of 19
 - SAT: minimum English section score of 450

Exceptions to the English proficiency exam score can be considered on a case-by-case basis for students from English-speaking countries or education in Englishinstructed schools.

We can offer conditional admission through the ECU Language Academy for students who do not meet the minimum English proficiency requirement.

* Students who have previously studied at a higher education institution outside the United States must submit a course-bycourse international credential evaluation from an NACESaccredited evaluation company.



Application Deadlines

- December 1: Deadline to be eligible to apply to the Honors College (fall admission only)
- December 15: Deadline for spring semester admission
- January 1: Deadline to be eligible to apply for other meritbased scholarships (Please note: Scholarships are not awarded upon admission.)
- July 15: Deadline for fall semester admission
