

STUDENT VISA CHECKLIST

ATTENDING ECU ON AN F1 VISA

STEP 1: ACADEMIC APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Application
- Academic records (transcripts)

STEP 2: STUDENT VISA APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Passport ID page
- Confidential Financial Form
- Supporting bank documents (eg. statements or scholarship documents) no older than six (6) months

Once we have all of the above, we will send you:

- Form I-20

Once you receive the I-20, you must go online and do the following:

- Pay the I-901/SEVIS fee (<https://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901>)
- Complete the DS-160 & pay the fee (<https://travel.state.gov/content/travel/en/us-visas/visa-information-resources/forms/ds-160-online-nonimmigrant-visa-application.html>)

You can now book a student visa interview online. Find embassies at www.usembassy.gov.

- Check the interview embassy website. There is sometimes interview information for that specific location.
- Inform us of your interview date.

We advise students to take all of the following to their interview. Most interviews are 2-3 minutes, so be organized!

Academic documents

- Offer letter of admission
- Transcripts used to gain admission

Immigration Documents

- Passport
- Form I-20
- DS-160 barcode page
- I-901 payment confirmation
- Confidential Financial Form
- Financial documents used to issue the I-20
- Interview booking confirmation
