## Become a Global Fellow

ECU's Global Fellows Program is designed to position high-achieving students for success in today's global, multicultural society.

### Year 1: Start Your Journey

Live in Ballard Hall as part of a Global Fellows community and enroll in two special classes during your first year. In the fall, take part in a specially designed first year seminar and in the spring participate in special sections of ECU's [award-winning Global Understanding course](#). In this student-centered course you will meet and interact in real-time with college students from around the world through video conferences and in-class discussions.

### Year 2: Explore Your World

As an ECU Global Fellow you receive a \$1,500 scholarship to participate in one of 40+ summer faculty-led study abroad programs. Or you can use your scholarship to enroll for a full semester in any one of over 200 partner universities abroad, all while paying your regular ECU tuition. You are also eligible to take classes during a semester or summer at [ECU's campus in Tuscany, Italy](#).



### Year 3: Build Your Resume

During your junior year, Global Fellows have special opportunities to build their resume. Fellows can become Global Ambassadors, work on campus as Global Interns, or participate in other leadership and mentoring activities. These programs provide opportunities to engage with prospective study abroad and international students and demonstrate to potential employers that you are qualified, motivated and prepared to succeed.

### Year 4: Prepare for Your Future

Throughout your time at ECU, Global Fellows engage with professional staff on campus to maximize your career trajectory. In a globally focused Career Preparation Series we will guide you through effective resume and cover letter writing, interviewing, understanding the job search process, and leveraging your study abroad experience in the workplace. As a graduating senior you will have built a solid foundation for success.
